

2024 Players Agreement

Sun Peaks Golf Course



Booking & Arrival

- Email and a valid credit card on file are required for booking.
- 24-hour cancellation policy. No-shows will be charge \$30 +tax per golfer.
- Arrive 30 minutes before your tee time at the Pro Shop, and 5 minutes before at the first tee.
- All players must be present at the Pro Shop and then start from the first tee.
- Maximum of 4 players per tee-time. Each player must have their own set of clubs.
- Pairings will be made at the discretion of the Pro Shop; singles must be paired up.
- Non-golfers (riders/walkers accompanying golfers) will only be permitted with advance permission and when possible. We cannot guarantee a cart will be available for extras.
 - Seat must be paid for when riding.
- Children under 6 are not permitted on the course, and ages 6-14 must be with an adult.

Rental Equipment - Power Carts & Clubs

- Must be 19+ and hold a valid credit card to rent equipment.
- A rental waiver must be signed. The person renting equipment is liable and will be charged for any and all observed damages caused to the cart, clubs, or course while under their care.
- Return cart and club rentals prior to Pro Shop closing hours (see daily operation hours).
- Maximum 2 riders per cart.
- For those under 19 years, a valid Driver's License is required.
 - Must be accompanied by someone over 19 with a credit card, who will assume responsibility and liability.

Pace of Play

- Keep up to the group in front at all times (within 1 shot of group ahead).
- As a reference, a playing time of maximum 2 hours 15 minutes shall be used per 9 holes.
- 8am-10am tee times; groups are expected to play in 2 hours 5 minutes or less per 9 holes.
- Play from handicap appropriate tees.
- Play "ready golf" - be ready to play when it is your shot.
- Take clubs you might need for your next shot (wedge and putter on green approach).
- Play best-ball or scramble with newer players, or if you are behind pace of play.

Alcohol & Smoking

- Outside alcohol is **NOT PERMITTED**, and will be confiscated, as we are a licensed facility.
- Playing privileges may be suspended or revoked. PLEASE DRINK RESPONSIBLY.
- Smoking is **NOT PERMITTED** on the Golf Course. (tobacco, vaping and cannabis).

Conduct & Safety

- Verbal abuse towards staff and other players will not be tolerated.

- Make sure the group in front is clearly out of range before you make a shot.
- Listen to and respect the Player's Assistants as they are there to ensure everyone is having an enjoyable experience, and to maintain pace of play.

Course Care

- Sand/seed and repair your divots and ball marks on the putting green.
- Rake bunkers after you play from them.
- Stay on cart paths and fairways where available and keep power carts and pull carts away from greens and tees.
- Avoid wet areas and high traffic spots to reduce turf damage. **NO** quick or sharp turns.
- No sunflower seeds, nuts with shells, or glass are permitted on the course.

Dress Code

- Shirts and shoes are to be worn at all times.
- Shirts must have sleeves, the exception being sleeveless golf-specific shirts.
 - Tank tops, swimwear and cut offs are **NOT PERMITTED**.
- Tailored pants or jeans in good condition. Shorts/skorts must have minimum 4-inch seam.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn. No flip flops, heels, or heavy treaded boots allowed.
- You may be asked to change or purchase proper attire to play.

Public Compliance

- 1st warning – Asked to correct behaviour/action.
- 2nd warning – Verbal warning to correct behaviour/action.
- Final warning – You will be asked to leave and no refund issued.
- Damage to carts and other property – Playing privileges suspended until paid in full.

Member Compliance

- 1st warning – Verbal warning to correct behaviour/action.
- 2nd warning – Temporary suspension of playing privileges.
- Final warning – Playing privileges will be revoked and no refund issued.
- Damage to carts and other property – Playing privileges suspended until paid in full.

As a golfer, you are responsible for your actions and behaviour on the golf course, including the flight of your ball. Injury and risk are an inherent part of the nature of the game and Sun Peaks Resort LLP and its Golf Course assume no liability or responsibility for such inherent hazards. Any damages or injury caused by you should be reported immediately to the involved parties and to the Pro Shop. Sun Peaks Golf Course will deal with all matters of this nature according to Canadian government laws and will assist or prosecute where necessary.
