Encircled by three mountains, Sun Peaks' European-inspired, pedestrian village, features 45+ locally-owned restaurants, shops and accommodations. The summer months reveal a lush paradise where guests can golf on British Columbia's highest golf course, hike through wildflowers, explore the lift-access mountain bike park, or paddle the lakes, learning about Canada's storied past.









- Village elevation is 1250m's (4000ft)

The Sun Peaks Bike Park offers 2,000 feet of lift-access vertical on Tod Mountain plus an additional 1,559 feet on Sundance Mountain. With trails ranging from flowy machinemade cruisers to fully pinned DH single-track there is something for every level of rider.

   Chairlifts run daily from 10am 7pm, (5pm after Sept 6)
- Mid June Late Sept
- 40 distinct alpine trails

The Progression Park is carpet liftaccessed bike park, perfect for kids and beginners of all ages to practice core skills.

- Carpets Runs daily from 10am 7pm (5pm after Sept early).
- Mid June late September
- Features include mini berm lines, technical lines, a jump line, drop section, pump track & more!
- Multiple options for tickets to access the Progression Park
- Lessons available for all levels







Explore scenic McGillivray Lake by canoe, kayak or paddleboard.

- June October
- Rentals come equipped with all necessary equipment
- Rentals are full day (8hrs)
- Participants must have prior experience
- Guests check in at the Activities Sales Desk, then selfdrive to the lake where the canoes/kayaks are located (6km)

With greens located at 1,200 meters above sea level Sun Peaks has BC's highest elevation course.

Along the way, 'Jeeping with Joe's passionate local guides will unlock the mysteries of the region's rich flora and fauna, offering captivating insights into its ecological wonders.

The Sun Peaks Plaza is a newly built public open space park located near the Sun Peaks Centre.

- Features include a concert amphitheatre & accessible adventure playground
- Grassy picnic and resting areas

- Short term parking stalls located next to the playground

Located in the East end of the Village are 2 tennis courts and an additional dedicated pickleball court.

- Access is through the entrance to Parking lot 5, follow the trail behind the school portables
- No washrooms on site
- Open daily with free public access
- Limited pickleball rackets available on site, no tennis rackets available







Sun Peaks is the perfect starting point for a variety of day trips to explore the surrounding area.



- Washrooms available (excluding showers) at the Annex












