Tucked in a powdery pocket in the Interior of British Columbia, you'll find Canada's second largest ski area.

Sun Peaks is a 45-minute drive from the Kamloops Airport where WestJet, Air Canada and Pacific Coastal provide direct flights from major cities such as Vancouver, Calgary, and Victoria. You can also fly to Kelowna International Airport, a two-hour and 30-minute drive to Sun Peaks. Shuttles are available from both Kamloops and Kelowna airports. The alpine village features nine hotels and lodges lining a ski-through village, alongside over 45 restaurants and shops. Three interconnecting mountains encircle the pedestrian-only village and are covered in light, dry snowfall that's complemented by award-winning grooming. On the slopes, a myriad of bucket list activities await, such as ice fishing, snowshoeing, and snowmobiling.

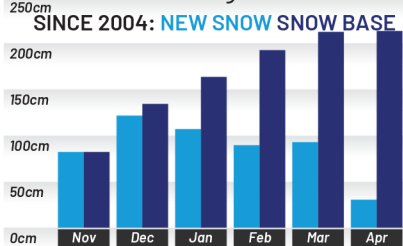
