Location

Sun Peaks is located in the Interior of British Columbia, 45 minutes from Kamloops, BC.

Closest Airport: Kamloops (YKA) only a 45 minute drive to Sun Peaks

- Serviced by Air Canada, West Jet, and Pacific Coastal
- Direct flights from Vancouver, Calgary, and Victoria

Secondary Airport- Kelowna (YLW) 2.5 hour drive from Sun Peaks

- Direct flights: Air Canada from Toronto, Alaska Airlines from Seattle



Dog Sled Tours



Guided Ice Fishing



Learn everything you need to know about dog sled tours in Canada, before heading out on your exhilarating dog sled adventure at Sun Peaks. All sleds are guided but guests may be given the opportunity to drive the sled. Single or double sleds are available.

- Into the Wild Tour (1.5hrs)

Enjoy the winter sunrise, some mid-day blue skies or a stunning sunset out on the hard water on a fully guided ice fishing adventure with Elevated Fishing Adventures.

Snowmobile Tours



Snowmobile tours head into the Sun Peaks backcountry where guests ride on a variety of forest trails and clear meadows.

- Daytime Tours -twice daily- 2 hours
- Tuesday & Friday evening tours, 1.5 hours
- Each sled can hold 2 guests (valid drivers licenses required)
- Mandatory \$25 insurance required
- Includes return shuttle from the main village

Alpine Fondue & Ski Experience



Board the Sunburst Express chairlift for an exclusive twilight ride to Sunburst Bar + Eatery and enjoy a hearty three course fondue meal. After dinner ski or board down a freshly groomed 5 Mile run glittering in the moonlight, with the help of a head torch and a guide.

- Dinners on Wednesdays and Thursdays mid-December to Mid-March
- Reservations must be made in advance
- Participants need to be an intermediate ski/snowboard level and comfortable on blue terrain



Snowshoeing

Explore the extensive snowshoe trail system by booking one of many snowshoe tours, or rent snowshoes and venture out on your own.

- Winter Wonderland Tour (2hrs) : Monday, Thursday, & Saturday
- Alpine Snowshoe Tour (2hrs) : Friday & Sunday, includes walk-on lift ticket
- Moonlight Snowshoe & S'mores (2hrs) : Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays & Mondays
- Snowshoe Fondue Tour: Sundays, maxmim 8 guests

Sleigh Rides



Ice Rink

Tube Park

With its curving lanes, Tube Time is a ride unlike any other lift accessed tube park.

Ages 3+ are welcome and tubes are provided. Purchase your tickets at the Activities Desk, located in the Village Day Lodge. The tube park is accessed via the carpet lift located beside the Village Platter Lift.

- Daily 2:00pm – 7:00pm, booked in 2hr timeslots
- Kids aged 3-5 ride free




Toboggan

Complimentary toboggan hill with lights throughout the evening, giving families a place to get together and let the kids expend their last bits of energy from the day. The hill has also been built up and graded to provide a better slope for sledding.

- Located at the base of the Morrissey and Orient chairlifts
- Guests must provide their own toboggans

Cat Trax Groomer Rides



Join a snowcat operator for a ride through the mountains while they groom a run.

- Operates nightly from mid December
- 1 guest per snowcat ride, max 2 snow cats per night
- Approximately a 45 minute ride (+/-10 minutes depending on the run being groomed)

Enjoy an evening at a Kamloops Blazers hockey game. Cheer on the local 3 time WHL Memorial Cup Champions as they face their opponents on home ice throughout the season.

Fat Biking



Similar to regular mountain bikes fat bikes are intended for off-road cycling with wider oversized tires to handle the snow. Bike rentals available in the village.

Trails available for fat biking:

- Shared use with Nordic trails (only to be used with temps below 0 degrees), signs show which trail allow bikes
- The Valley Trail network that winds through out the village
- Single track trails -Family Man loop & Phat Rabbit
