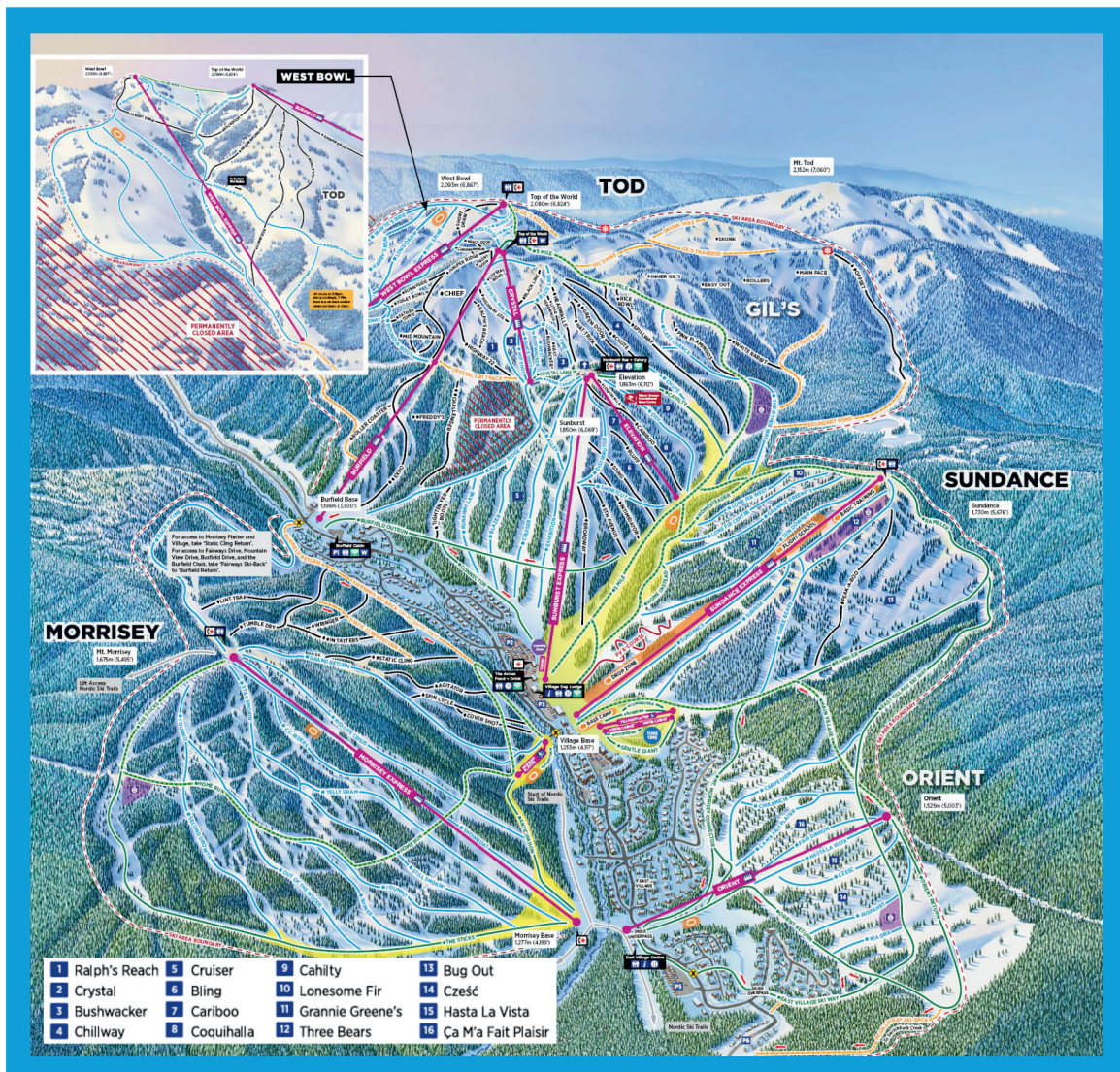
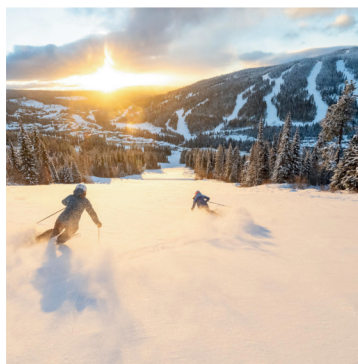

Tucked in a powdery pocket in the Interior of British Columbia, you'll find Canada's second largest ski area.

Sun Peaks is a 45-minute drive from the Kamloops Airport where WestJet, Air Canada and Pacific Coastal provide direct flights from major cities such as Vancouver, Calgary, and Victoria. You can also fly to Kelowna International Airport, a two-hour and 30-minute drive to Sun Peaks. Shuttles are available from both Kamloops and Kelowna airports. Three interconnecting mountains encircle the pedestrian-only village and are covered in light, dry snowfall that's complemented by award-winning grooming.

HEAPS OF BUCKET-LIST ACTIVITIES OFF THE SLOPES

From professional photo shoots and murder mystery games, to guided ice fishing trips and Cat Trax groomer rides, Sun Peaks has heaps of activities for everyone in your group. You can start your day with a spin class or snowshoe tour, take in a Nancy Greene Welcome Reception and the ArtZone artist installations, then head into Kamloops for a Blazers hockey game. In addition to year-round activities, the local events calendar is bursting at the seams with live music, culinary showcases, action-packed competitions and camps, and low-key karaoke and trivia nights to enjoy Sun Peaks at your leisure.
