A low pressure system will move to coastal B.C. today with a frontal system moving across southern B.C. Occasional snow is expected to develop this morning ending near noon today. An upper trough expected for tonight giving flurries for the overnight period. The upper trough will move east of the area on Monday. Lingering flurries likely Monday morning with sunny periods for Monday afternoon. Gusty winds for today. Highs on the slopes near minus 7 C both days.


